1. Fully participate in the entire camp program: activities, meetings, meals & events.
2. NEVER be alone with a camper in a private setting (cabin, meeting room, forested area, etc.)
3. NEVER use or allow any kind of humiliation, hazing, or physical discipline with campers.
4. Ensure that all students' medications (except inhalers) are kept in the First Aid Station.
5. Immediately refer any information regarding disruptive campers to the Camp leadership.

I will fully cooperate with Camp staff, District staff, and program activities staff. If accepted, I promise to conduct myself in an exemplary manner, in the sight of the Lord, with the campers entrusted to me. Each volunteer is to:

1. Be a servant to campers—looking for opportunities to minister the love of Christ.
2. Be a model to campers what they are to be doing.
3. Be specifically responsible for the students assigned to his/her cabin.
4. Be available for ministry times during and after meeting, when in the cabins and during free time.
5. Be familiar with, follow, and enforce all rules and guidelines given during camp as stated in the “Campers Policies and Guidelines.”
6. Each church must complete and submit proof of a background check for each adult leader or volunteer.
A \$12 processing fee will be charged for each adult/volunteer application submitted without a completed background check.
