Children Volunteer Guidelines

Each volunteer is to:

1. Be a servant the campers—looking for opportunities to minister the love of Christ.
2. Be a model to campers what they are to be doing.
3. Be specifically responsible for the students assigned to his/her cabin.
4. Be available for ministry times during and after meetings, when in the cabins and during free time.
5. Be familiar with, follow, and enforce all rules and guidelines given during camp as stated in the "Campers Policies and Guidelines."

Failure to uphold the following guidelines will be grounds for dismissal from camp, and may expose applicant to legal liability:

1. Fully participate in the entire camp program: activities, meetings, meals & events.
2. NEVER be alone with a camper in a private setting (cabin meeting room, forested area, etc.)
3. NEVER use or allow any kind of humiliation, hazing, or physical discipline with campers.
4. Ensure that all students' medications (except inhalers) are kept in the First Air Station.
5. Immediately refer any information regarding disruptive campers to the Camp leadership.

Children Volunteer Application/Release: I affirm that all information provided here is true. I will follow the Volunteer Guidelines as stated above. I will fully cooperate with Camp staff, District staff, and program activities staff. If accepted, I promise to conduct myself in an exemplary manner, in the sight of the Lord, with the campers entrusted to me. Furthermore, I authorize any and all inquiries into the facts stated in this application. I understand and agree that such inquiries will include obtaining a criminal records report. I release any person, organization, or company from any and all liability, claims, or damages that may directly or indirectly result from the disclosure or use of any information about me that is revealed or obtained as part of the review of this application. I certify that I have carefully read and understand the above statements. A copy of this signed authorization and release may be relied upon in lieu of the original.
